CRAFT SAFETY POCKET BOOK

Confined Space Entry

- → Ensure attendant is present at all times during confined space entry.
- → Do not allow entry without verifying means of communication is in place with attendant.
- → Need to be able to escape.
- → Need permit to enter.





Barricades and Signs

- → Dangerous areas marked with red/ black danger tape.
- → Caution areas marked with yellow/ black barrier tape.
- → Use hard (rigid) barricades in areas where work will.





Scaffolding

- → Utilize fall protection gear (harness and lanyards) If instructed.
- → Scaffold Inspection Tags:





Cranes and Lifting Operations


→ Fully barricade the swing radius by red/black danger tape.





Excavation and Trenching

- → Do not place materials within 0.6m of the excavation.
- → Keep soft barricades at least 1.8m from edge.
- → Keep hard (rigid) barricades at least 0.6m from the edge.
- → Ensure ladders extend 0.9m from lip of excavation and placed no more than 7.6m from any worker.
- → Shore back/bench trenches to a safe angle of repose.



Portable Ladders

- → Use non-metallic ladders.
- → Maintain three points of contact at all times during use.
- → Place the base of the ladder at a distance away from the building at a ratio of 1:4.

General Safe Practices

- → Ensure guards on all tools prior to using.
- → Don't stand under lifting loads.
- Use double eye protection during welding and when operating.
 machinery that yields flying chips or debris.
- → Always wear seat belts in vehicles or Plant Equipment.
- → Do not use mobile devices.



Defeating Safety Devices

- → Never change a safety device. This includes the following:
 - > Removing equipment handles
 - Removing rotating equipment guards
 - > Failing to inspect tools
 - Not following JHA, Permits
 - Fixing triggers in the on position
 - Hard wiring electrical wires into outlets





Fall Protection

- → Cover floor openings with engineered material, and mark "Floor Opening — DO NOT REMOVE".
- → Hard Barricades or Structures used.
