This procedure applies to works performed under all Government construction projects executed throughout the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

#### 2.0 SCOPE

This procedure applies to all Entities. It is used to identify the Coding Structure to be used in all estimates, quantity reporting, procurement, cost control, historical databases for all new Entity's projects.

The Project Cost Coding Structures Procedure EPM-KPC-PR-000001 covers all the coding requirements and shall be used as the coding procedure for all estimates.
